

What is Nuotta?



Nuotta is a coaching camp for all young people aged 14–29 who are in need of social empowerment.

Nuotta coaching strengthens the social and life management skills and healthy living habits of young people.

Free of charge for young people within outreach youth work and youth workshops.

Activity-based and experiential methods in a small group.

Group and individual support.

Typically lasting from 2 to 4 days.

Organised in nine national youth centres all around Finland.

Nuotta coaching is part of the social empowerment service package offered by the Ministry of Education and Culture:

The Ministry of Education and Culture supports the participation of workshop groups and outreach youth work in Nuotta. The sending party covers the travel costs.
